

## 4 x 4 Aristel PABX – Door Phone Interface

The 4 x 4 Aristel Pabx is pre programmed for 1 x PSTN Line connection, 3 x Analogue Extensions that all ring for an incoming PSTN Line call, and a Door Telephone that will ring the first Extension # 11.

The purpose of this set up is to allow a PSTN Line connection and a Door Phone connection with differential ring between both types of calls.

The ideal use of this type of product is for Caravan parks or other accommodation sites that are small in size and have a manager on site that can be away from the front desk walking around the property.

### Connections

- Line 1 – connect to the PSTN Line outlet using an RJ11 lead
- TEL 1 – Connect to the first Telephone Handset – Engenius Durafon
- TEL 2 – Connect to the second Desktop Handset – SLT 70
- TEL 3 – Connect to the second Desktop Handset – SLT 70
- TEL 4 – Door Phone

### Configuration

- Line 1 rings TEL 1, TEL 2, TEL 3
  - Transferring the call by pressing the Flash/Recall of the telephone device and then dialling \* and the extension number. Ie \*11 for TEL 1, \*12 for TEL 2 etc.
- When the Door Phone talk button is pressed it will make TEL 1 ring via a pre-programmed hotline facility
- If you have a Music On Hold source – plug it into the 3.5mm audio input socket of the 4x4 Aristel Pabx system.

Please see attached diagram for the solution offered.

Other configurations can be programmed if needed – setup changes are an optional extra.

### **\*NOTE\***

The telephone System has already been programmed to that of the above. Just plug the leads in as indicated.
